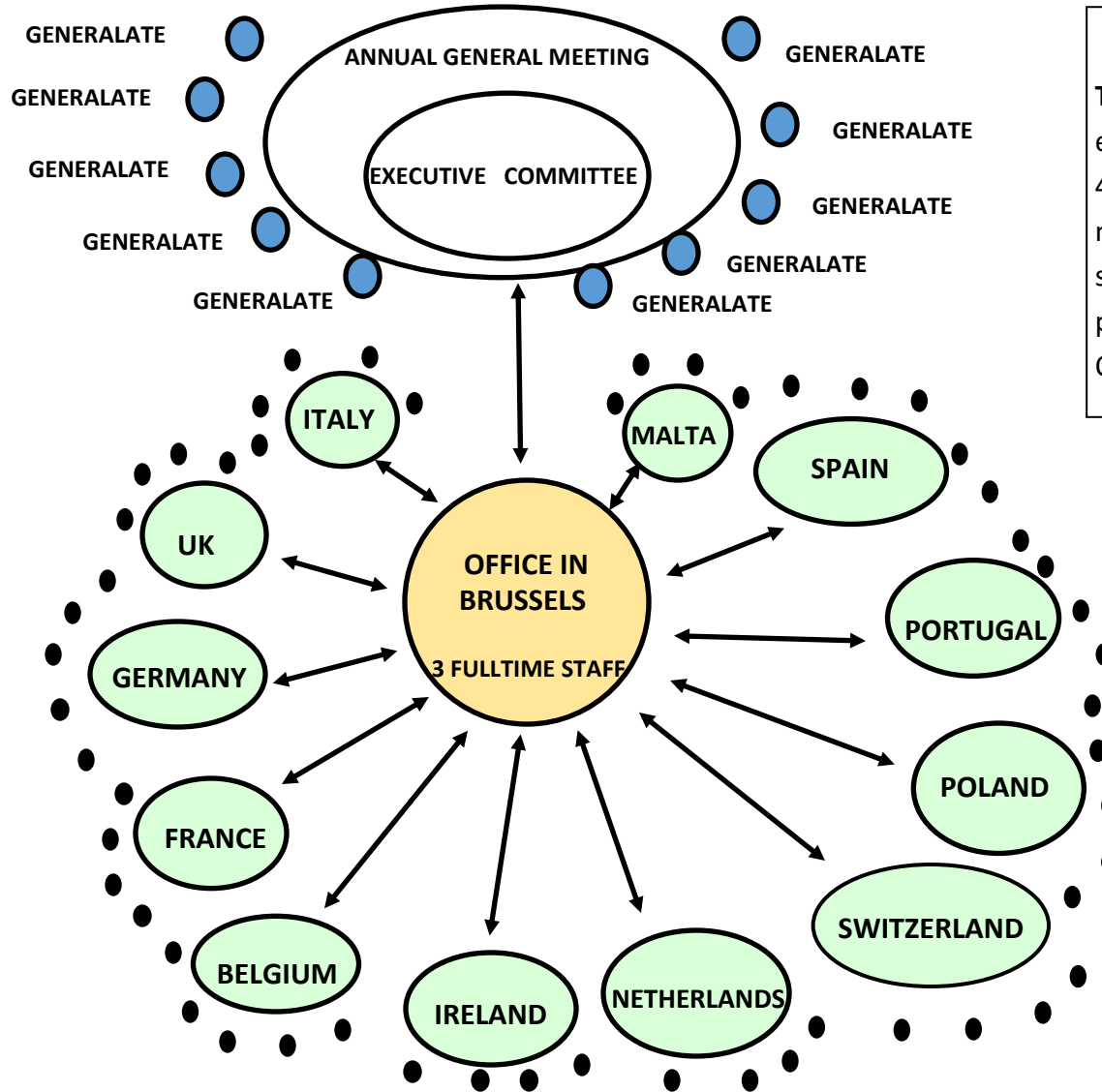

Networking

Congregational representatives form national **Antennae**. Their role is to share information on urgent issues with each other and with their own congregations, promoting the effective lobbying of government ministers and their own MPs. They network with other NGOs, supporting campaigns on issues of common concern. They receive updates from the Brussels Office on issues emerging from the European Parliament. Each antenna is independent, and has its own way of working and financing its activities.

Management

The **Executive Committee** is elected by representatives from 40 Missionary Generalates meeting in Rome. It appoints staff, oversees activities and provides finance for the Brussels Office.

The Brussels Staff are engaged in advocacy and lobbying with MEPs and officials at the European Commission, communicating with antennae members, maintaining a website, researching proposed EU legislation which may have negative impact on African countries, visiting Africa and networking with other NGOs. They organise an annual meeting attended by representatives from the Executive Committee and each Antenna.
